Do you watch clouds...

Jude was ready to write about the joy of salvation, yet saw something... that needed to be addressed now.

Jude 3 ... Contend for the Faith! (CJB) Earnestly Contend for the Faith!

(OJB) Urgently appeal to Fight for the Faith!

Contend: To struggle to surmount a difficulty or danger.

Jude 4 (OJB) For certain men, men of wickedness, written down long ago, for this condemnation, have infiltrated our ranks, men twisting the Grace of God into a license for sensual self-indulgence & denying

our only *Master & Lord*, Yeshua the Messiah.

Be careful little ears what you hear, Is it of God or of man...

Do you "remember" the "good old days"?? That statement can be funny, good, or bad.

History Lessons Jude 5-7

Jude 5a (NRS) Now I desire to *Remind* you, though you are *fully informed*,

Remember...

Gen 8:1 But God *Remembered* Noah...

Exodus 10:2 "*Remember* the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.

Exodus 20:15 You shall *Remember* that you were a *slave in the land of Egypt & the Lord your God brought you out* from there with a mighty hand & an outstretched arm. Therefore the Lord your God commanded you to keep the Sabbath day.

Leviticus 26:40-42 "But if they confess their iniquity & the iniquity of their fathers in their treachery that they committed against Me, & also in walking contrary to Me,
41 so that I walked contrary to them & brought them into the land of their enemies—if then their uncircumcised heart is humbled & they make amends for their iniquity,
42 then I will *Remember* My Covenant with Jacob & I will *Remember* My Covenant with Isaac & Abraham & I will *Remember* the land.

Jude 5 (NRS) Now I desire to *Remind* you, though you are *fully informed*,
(contd- cjb) that *Adonai*, who once delivered the people from Egypt,
later destroyed those who did not have *Faith*.

Numbers 14:26-35

1 Corinth 10:(1-20):10 And don't grumble, as some of them did, & were destroyed by the
Destroying Angel.

Hebrews 3:12-18 Watch out, brothers, so that there will not be in any one of you an evil
heart lacking trust (without faith), which could lead you to turn from the living God!
13 Instead, keep exhorting each other every day, as long as it is called Today, so that none of
you will become hardened by the deceit of sin. 14 For we have become sharers in the
Messiah, provided, however, that we hold firmly to the conviction we began with, right
through until the goal is reached.
