1. Canonical Scripture: Authoritative Books in the Bible

Apocryphal Texts:

2. Apocrypha or Deuterocanonical Books: Considered by Catholics & Orthodox Christians. Writings of doubtful authenticity, although widely circulated as being true.

3. * Pseudepigrapha Books: Pseudo - false epigraph - to inscribe visionary books attributed to the ancients dealing with the mysteries of creation and the working out of good and evil from a gnostic standpoint.

Jewish writings ascribed to various biblical patriarchs and prophets but composed within approximately 200 years of the birth of Jesus Christ.

Was read during Jesus' time, known as the Book of Enoch
