

Jude 12 These are hidden reefs at your love feasts, as they feast with you *without fear*, shepherds feeding themselves; waterless clouds, swept along by winds; fruitless trees in late autumn, twice dead, uprooted;

Deuteronomy 10:12-14

Proverbs 9:10 *The fear of the Lord* is the beginning of wisdom & the knowledge of the Holy One is insight (understanding).

Revelation 2:8-9 “And to the angel of the church in Smyrna write: ‘The words of the first & the last, who died & came to life.

9 “I know your tribulation & your poverty (but you are rich) & the slander of those who say that they are Jews & are not, but are a synagogue of Satan.

Jude 14-16 Judgment of False Teachers ~ conclusion of Jude’s 2nd time bringing up an Apocryphal book ~ 1 Enoch

14a It was also about *these* that Enoch, the seventh from Adam,

Genesis 5:1-31

1.Adam 2.Seth 3.Enosh 4.Kenan 5.Mahalaleel 6.Jared 7.*Enoch* - Gen 5:21-24

Luke 3:37-38 ... same as listed above...

1 Enoch 93:3 And Enoch began to recount from the books & said: ‘*I was born the 7th* in the first week, able judgment & righteousness *still* endured.

Jude 14b prophesied, saying, “Behold, *the Lord comes* with *ten thousands of His Holy ones*, ... *So is this speaking of the 2nd Coming of Yeshua?*

Now read Deut 33:1-3

Deut 33:2 He said, “*The Lord came* from Sinai & dawned from Seir upon us; He shone forth from Mount Paran; He came from the *ten thousands of holy ones*, with flaming fire (a fiery law) at His right hand.

Jude 15 to execute judgment on all & to convict all the ¹⁾ *ungodly* of all *their* deeds of ²⁾ *ungodliness* that *they* have committed in such an ³⁾ *ungodly* way, & of all the harsh things that ⁴⁾ *ungodly* sinners have spoken against Him.”

1 Enoch 9 And behold! *He comes* with *10,000 of His Holy ones (saints)* to execute judgment on all, & to destroy all the ¹⁾ *ungodly* (wicked); & to convict all flesh of all the works of their ²⁾ *ungodliness* which they have ³⁾ *ungodly* committed, & of all the hard things which ⁴⁾ *ungodly* sinners have spoken against Him.

(1-4) *ungodly* also used in *Jude 4 & 18*.

What is the Lord going to do?

- 1. To execute judgment on all*
- 2. To convict all the ungodly of all their works/deeds of ungodliness they committed in an ungodly way*
- 3. To convict the ungodly from all the harsh things that they spoke against Him.*

Thus, there will be a judgment on what they have said & done.

Jude 16 *These are grumblers, malcontents (complainers), following their own sinful desires; they are loud-mouthed boasters, showing favoritism to gain advantage.*

“These”... ungodly false teachers, people refusing to continue to follow, obey or recognize Yeshua as Lord. What are “they” doing?

- 1. Grumbling - resentful discontent... as in the wilderness, & on & on...*
- 2. Complaining - fault finding... as the Pharisees, & on & on...*
- 3. Following/ walking in their ‘own’ sinful desires... it’s about ‘me’ syndrome.*

As in vs 11, “Oy/ Woe” is Cain, Balaam & Korah

What they are is what they do...

- 1. Loud mouthed boasters*
- 2. & showing favoritism... for their own advantage.*

Once again, it’s about what they have said & done.

Thus, this takes us back to Vs. 12...

Whom do they fear? Where is there knowledge & understanding?

Whom do we fear? Where is our knowledge & understanding coming from?

A Benediction from Sirach 50:22-24 & 28-29 (a closing prayer)

And now bless the God of all, Who everywhere works great wonders, Who fosters our growth from birth & deals with us according to His Mercy. May He give us gladness of heart & may there be peace in our days in Israel, as in the days of old. May He entrust to us His Mercy, & may He deliver us in our days!
